

Bus Routes 2020 -2021

Updated Friday, September 8, 2020

Notes for Students and Parents

- Masks are required on the school bus.
- Students will sit one per seat, unless from the same household.
- Large buses have between 22-24 seats, our smaller buses have 10-14 seats.
- Buses will unload and load a few at a time to allow social distancing.
- Due to the A – B scheduling each bus has a few as one student or as many as 18 -20.
- With students attending remote and parents transporting our normal ridership of 900+ is now around 600. Many of the stops are still scheduled in case a child needs to ride. The bus won't stop at those houses but that adds time to the route schedule in the routing system.
- Timing – An example is one route on "A" day has 3 stops, on "B" day has 12 stops. The routes "show" all 15 stops and the time it takes. In a case such as this, the A day the trip will be much shorter and the bus will come later.
- Arrival Times: NOTE: the AM arrival times are 30 minutes later than in the past, so the buses will be starting routes later. *See attached sheet for stops and times.
 - **HS-MS Times:**
 - Arrival and Drop off – 7:50 – 8:20.
 - Departure: 2:17 -3:00
 - **ES Times:**
 - Arrival and Drop off – 9:00 – 9:30.
 - Departure: 2:45 -3:20

*Bus routes times subject to change as new students enroll, or students add or delete transportation. This is a best estimate to provide a ballpark time.

- Pre-K: Buses depart the ES at 11:05 for home. Parents can expect arrival at home/daycare between 11:15 and 11:45. PU will begin around 11:45 – 12:00 so the buses can arrive at school at 12:25.
