2020-2021 Budget Vote and Board of Education Election

When is the Election?

School budget votes and board elections will take place on **June 9, 2020**. Voting is by absentee ballot only. There will be no in-person voting. The District will mail absentee ballots and a postage-paid return envelope to all qualified voters. Voters not receiving a ballot contact the District Clerk, 648-7543 or mcmullene@cforks.org, or pick one up at the District Office, 6 Patch Rd., between the hours of 8 a.m. to 3 p.m., June 1-5 or June 8-9. Ballots must be returned by 5 p.m. June 9.

Who is a Qualified Voter?

A qualified voter must be: a citizen of the United States, at least 18 years old, a resident of the school district for at least 30 days prior to the meeting at which he or she offers to vote, and not otherwise prohibited from voting by law.

2020-2021 PROPOSED BUDGET

Total: \$34,356,239

Budget Increase: .18% Tax Levy Increase: 2.18%

The budget also includes a renewal increase in the transportation summer contract. This is a 2-year contract. Year 1 increase is \$2,301; the total contract amount is \$80,197.
