

Emergency response plans

The Chenango Forks Central School District has a district Emergency Response Plan in effect and individual Building-Level Emergency Response Plans in place that are reviewed on an annual basis to ensure compliance with the Commissioner of Education's Regulation 155.17. This regulation was put into place to address emergencies that must be handled in an expeditious and effective manner. Schools are at risk for acts of violence as well as natural and man-made disasters. To address these threats, the State of New York has enacted the Safe Schools Against Violence in Education (SAVE) law. The district and school response plans address the prevention, response and recovery with respect to a variety of emergencies in schools.
