

McKinney-Vento Act - Homeless Rights

The McKinney-Vento Act is a federal law that protects the educational rights of children and youth living in temporary housing situations such as:

- in emergency or transitional housing
- sharing housing due to loss of housing or economic hardship
- in a motel, hotel or camping grounds due to lack of other housing
- in a car, park, public space, abandoned building or bus or train station
- in any of the above housing arrangements and are eligible for the Migrant Education Program.
