

NOTICE OF ANNUAL SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETING AND BUDGET VOTE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing of the qualified voters of the Chenango Forks Central School District (the "School District"), a school district of the State of New York, located in the counties of Broome and Chenango, will be held on the 9th day of May 2013 at the Middle School located in Binghamton, New York at 7:00 p.m. (prevailing time), for presentation of the proposed budget for the following school year. The budget will be available for review on May 2nd, 2013 and thereafter at the School District office.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the annual meeting of the qualified voters of the Chenango Forks Central School District, a school district of the State of New York, located in the counties of Broome and Chenango, will be held at the High School Auditorium in Binghamton, New York, on the 21st day of May, 2013, beginning at 12:00 o'clock P.M. (EST), to consider (i) a proposition to vote upon the appropriation of the necessary funds to meet the estimated expenditures or for any propositions involving the expenditure of money or the authorizing of levy of taxes, (ii) a proposition to vote on the election of members of the Board of Education. The polls shall be open until 9:00 o'clock P.M. (EST). At such meeting taxes to be levied by installment will be proposed. The following propositions will be submitted at said meeting and shall state the taxes to be proposed, the objects or purposes for which such taxes will be authorized, and the maximum amount to be expended for such objects or purposes:

PROPOSITION NO: 1

1. The Board of Education of Chenango Forks Central School District is hereby authorized to adopt the proposed annual School District Budget for the 2013-2014 fiscal year, presented to the voters at the School District Budget Hearing held on May 9, 2013, and the requisite portion thereof to be raised by taxation on the taxable property of the School District.

PROPOSITION NO. 2

1. The Board of Education is authorized to elect one candidate as member of the Board of Education to serve a five-year term beginning July 1, 2013 and commencing June 30, 2018.

NOTICE IS FUTHER GIVEN that Petitions nominating candidates for the office of member of the Board of Education must be filed with the Clerk of the School District between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. not later than April 22, 2013. A five-year term ending June 30, 2018, presently held by Judy Warner, is to be filled. Each petition must be addressed to the Clerk of the School District, be signed by at least 25 qualified voters of the School District, shall state the residence of each signer, the name and address of the candidate, and shall describe the specific vacancy on the Board of Education for which the candidate is nominated, which description shall include at least the length of term of office, and the name of the last incumbent.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN, that applications for absence ballots for the annual district meeting, in accordance with Section 2018-a of the Education Law, may be obtained from the office of the School District Clerk. The completed application for absentee ballot must be received by the School District Clerk no later than seven (7) days preceding the vote on May 21, 2013. A list of all persons to whom absentee ballots shall have been issued will be available in the office of the School

District Clerk on each of the five days prior to the day of the annual district meeting, except Sunday. Absentee ballots must be received in the office of the School District Clerk no later than 5:00 o'clock P.M. on the day of the annual district meeting.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the qualified voters of the School District shall be entitled to vote at said annual vote and election. A qualified voter is one who is (1) a citizen of the United States of America, (2) eighteen years of age or older, and (3) resident within the School District for a period of thirty (30) days preceding the annual vote and election. The School District may require all persons offering to vote at the budget vote and election to provide one form of proof of residency pursuant to Education Law §2018-c. Such form may include a driver's license, a non-driver identification card, a utility bill, or a voter registration card. Upon offer of proof of residency, the School District may also require all persons offering to vote to provide their signature, printed name and address.
