



## CFHS & CFMS Student COVID-19 Zoom Expectations

***Note: Only students that are quarantined due to COVID-19 or awaiting a test result for COVID-19 can Zoom for class instruction, following your 9-period schedule. For all other absences, students cannot Zoom and should check Schoology for classwork, email teachers with questions, and are encouraged to stay for remedial upon your return.***

- A Zoom link will be posted in the materials section of Schoology for each class.
- If school is made aware of a student having to quarantine/symptomatic prior to the start of the school day and the student is feeling well enough, the student must Zoom that day.
- If a student comes to school and is sent home due to quarantine/symptoms, online learning via Zoom will start the next school day.
- It is our expectation that you will be able to hear the instruction of the teacher, be able to access materials on Schoology for the lesson, and the teacher will share his/her screen to the best of their ability. Outside of this, it will be up to the teacher's discretion how they approach the Zoom lesson.
- For morning attendance and to start the class, each student must have their video on and be on the screen to be counted as present.
- Students should have their name, spelled correctly, on the Zoom screen in order to be admitted into the class. Students need to make sure they are muted upon entrance into class and remain muted during the period. You should only unmute if you are called on by the teacher, at the teacher's discretion.
- Students should be on time for all classes, outside of lunch and study hall (other than Period 1). If you are not on time, you may not be admitted to the class and will be marked absent. If you are having internet issues, please call the main office.
- Once the class begins, it will be the teacher's discretion if videos of students will be left on. However, students must be active listeners and following along with the lesson/class.
- It is up to the teacher's discretion if they will have students speak and ask questions during the lesson. Students should ask questions in the chat, via Schoology message, or send your teacher an email.
- If you are called on to speak, please speak clearly, look up, and speak at the computer microphone. Stay on topic (no side conversations).
- Students need to find a quiet place to work.
- Please ensure that school appropriate clothing is worn at all times and your background is school appropriate. For example, you should not be in your bed.
- Some classes are not conducive for student Zoom (ie. PE, science lab, wood working, etc). When this occurs, students should check in and then work on asynchronous coursework.
- Assessments will not be given to students during quarantine. These should be made up upon return to school.
- During online class lessons, be focused, be attentive and be an active participant. Students should not be doing other activities, outside of class activities, while in a Zoom class. This is school and this is your education!
